- Tot 1, 2, 3, 4
 - Ages 4-5
 - No Experience
 - Helmets Required
- Pre-Alpha
 - Ages 6 & Up
 - No Experience
 - Helmets Required
- Alpha
 - Age may vary
 - Prerequisite Tot levels and/or Pre-Alpha based on age

2 Intermediate Skating Program

(Prerequisite - Alpha)

*Strongly recommend the purchase of personal skates at this point.

- Gamma

- Freestyle 2

B) Freestyle

- Freestyle Levels 1-10
- Each level contains jumps, spins, footwork and connecting move elements

Freestyle Sessions

- Freestyle sessions are the allotted practice slot for figure skaters
 - Any skater that is Beta level and above has the ability to utilize this ice time
 - Please speak to the Skating Director for details on price, rules and what to expect for first-time skaters on the sessions
- Private Lessons take place on Freestyle sessions

(No Prerequists)

- Speak to Skating Director for more information:
 - There are no age or level restrictions, but recommended as the skater approaches the Freestyle 1 level
 - Selection process of a private lesson instructor that is right for the skater
- Discuss goals that the skater may have
- Determine the skater's discipline:
 - Ice Dance, Pairs, Singles, Synchro
- Determine if the skater wants to skate recreationally or competitively
- Discuss potential skating show opportunities for all levels
